

Zagros Liberal Alliance was established of the 3 political Parties in the three nations, which are not Persian nation and their country is under Iranian regime. It is Eastern Kurdistan, Ahwaz and Caspian; ratify the International Covenant on the Rights of Indigenous Nations.

After April meeting, come new members other political parties in other non-Persian nations joining the Zagros Alliance.

A. The Zagros Liberal Alliance, was established from the three no-Persian nations political parties,

B. 1- Party Serbesti Kurdistan (PSK). Kurdish Language- 2- Ahwaz Liberal Party Arabic Language. Caspian Democratic Party, Caspian languages ( Gilaki )

C. being indigenous to the Zagros Mountains region of the area Iran, do hereby establish and submit the following:

The indigenous leaders of the Zagros Mountains of no-Persian nation under the Iranian control have engaged in a global dialogue concerning the International Covenant on the Rights of Indigenous Nations.

D. Indigenous governments, including the tribal nations of Kurds, Caspian, Ahwaz, are seeking official status as Self-determinations governments of their nation in its geography area region.

E. The International Covenant on the Rights of Indigenous Nations recognizes the “regular and permanent status” of constitutional and customary indigenous governments such as under this Zagros Liberal Alliance.

F. Zagros Liberal Alliance partners are actively addressing human rights issues like violence against indigenous women, including establishing a monitoring mechanism of the Covenant and appointing a Special Rapporteur to focus on violence against indigenous women and children as war crimes.

G. Other constitutional and customary governments of indigenous peoples acknowledge our rights as self-governing nations.

H. Zagros tribes advocate for “regular and permanent status” of constitutional and customary indigenous governments.

I. Indigenous governments of Zagros currently have a formal ‘consultative status’ and are relied upon in matters affecting indigenous peoples.

J. A document recommending the implementation of the International Covenant on the Rights of Indigenous Nations was created with input from all the indigenous nations of Zagros.

K. Pursuant to the universal application of the right of self-determination for all peoples, all Zagros nations under this Covenant wish to be recognized as Indigenous Peoples and Nations based on inherent freedom, inherent sovereignty and our right to self-determination under international law with established borders, leadership and governments including traditional councils and authorities.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND ADOPTED, that:


1. The Zagros Nations governments hereby commit themselves to upholding and implementing the International Covenant on the Rights of Indigenous Nations.
2. The tribal nations who participated in these meetings will continue to push for full and effective participation for indigenous nations and are committed to acting as a resource for other tribes wanting to participate in this International Covenant on the Rights of Indigenous Nations.
3. Indigenous nations under the International Covenant on the Rights of Indigenous Nations need an active, direct voice within the global community, especially considering that indigenous nations remain at the forefront of the world's most challenging issues in Iran, from climate change to poverty.
4. A new monitoring body will be incorporated within Iran's Zagros Mountains autonomous region to help guide implementation of the International Covenant on the Rights of Indigenous Nations.

FINALLY BE IT RESOLVED, that this resolution shall be the policy of Zagros autonomous governments until it is withdrawn or modified by subsequent resolution.
